[3] **Baker, Maude Eudora Long**, b. 26 Dec 1882, Athens, Ga., d. 19--, married 30 Jan 1935 to George Baker, divorced c1940. Granddaughter of Dr. Long. Lived with parents in San Antonio, Tx., from 1883.

[3] **Baker, George**, b. unknown, d. unknown, married 30 Jan 1935 to Maude Eudora Long, divorced c1940.

[2] **Bartow, Florence Cornelia Long**, b. 19 Nov 1853, Athens, Ga., d. 1 Jul 1919, Athens, Ga. Daughter of Dr. Long. Moved to San Antonio, Tx., with her mother in 1883, married John L. Bartow 10 Nov 1884. She and her husband lived in Texas and Utah; after 1896 returned to Georgia and lived with her sister, Eugenia, and brother-in-law, A. O. Harper, first in Elbert County, and later in Athens. A.O. Harper died 26 Jun 1919; his death so upset Mrs. Bartow that she died five days later.

[2] **Bartow, Col. John Lowe**, b. 1852, d. 29 Apr 1897, married 10 Nov 1884 to Florence Cornelia Long. Bartow was a colonel in the Confederate army. He was a newspaperman in Waco, Tx., both before and after his marriage, and in Provo, Utah, until 1896.

[7] **Borum, Sarah "Sallie" Ware Sanders**, b.10 Mar 1792, Madison County, Ga., d. 21 Oct 1863, Madison County, Ga., married Britton T. Sanders 13 Nov 1810, married Benjamin Borum 3 Dec 1818. Aunt of Dr. Long.

[8] **Burns, John Milton**, b. 12 Dec 1833, Franklin County, Ga., d. 21 Nov 1908, Jackson County, Ga., married Sarah Harriet Long 3 Jul 1856. Occupation: physician.

[8] **Burns, Sarah Harriet Long**, b. 7 Oct 1837, Madison County, Ga., d. 27 Sep 1877, Jackson County, Ga., married John Milton Burns 3 Jul 1856. First cousin of Dr. Long; daughter of Thomas Wilson Long.

[4] **Coleman, Cynthia Swain**, b. 11 Feb 1791, d. 29 Mar 1829, married c1811 to William Coleman. Sister of George D. Swain, Dr. Long's father-in-law.

[4] **Coleman, William**, b. 3 Mar 1785, d. 21 Jan 1874, married c1811 to Cynthia Swain. Resided most of his life near Asheville, N.C.; occupation, hatter.

[5] **Dilworth, Andrew Boyd**, b. 14 Dec 1814, d. 2 Jul 1894, married 7 Jan 1840 to Sarah Catherine Taylor. Resided most of his life in northern Mississippi, where he served as Secretary of State from 1855-1860 and as Quartermaster for the Confederate States of America from 1861-1862. Occupation, farmer.

[5] **Dilworth, Sarah Catherine Taylor**, b. 18 Sep 1818, d. 13 Sep 1876, married 7 Jan 1840 to Andrew Boyd Dilworth. Sister of Frances Taylor Swain, Dr. Long's mother-in-law. Resided most of her life in northern Mississippi.

[8] **Etchison, Elizabeth Wilson Long**, b. 1814, Madison County, Ga., d. 1887, Walton Co., Ga., married John Etchison 5 Feb 1856, Madison County, Ga. First cousin of Dr. Long; daughter of Thomas Wilson Long.

[8] **Etchison, John**, b. 16 Jun 1794, Elbert County, Ga., d. 8 Oct 1881, Walton County, Ga., married Elizabeth Wilson Long 5 Feb 1856. Occupation: farmer.

[2] **Harper, Eugenia Anna Long**, b. 21 Aug 1856, Athens, Ga., d. 5 Jul 1940, Fulton Co., Ga., married 1888 to Alexander Omer Harper. Daughter of Dr. Long.

[7] **Higgenbotham, Judith Ware**, b. 3 May 1805, Amherst, Va., d. Sep 1870, Opelousas, La., married 9 Jan 1831 to Nelson E. Higgenbotham. Aunt of Dr. Long.

[7] **Higgenbotham, Nelson E.**, b. 1778, Virginia, d. 2 Sep 1860, Opelousas, La., married 9 Jan 1831 to Judith Ware. Brother of Samuel Higgenbotham. Occupation: farmer.

[8] **Long, Anna Williamson**, b. 28 Dec 1815, Madison County, Ga., d. 13 Feb 1893, Jackson County, Ga. First cousin of Dr. Long; daughter of Thomas Wilson Long.

[2] **Long, Arthur Beaugard**, b. 27 Jul 1858, Athens, Ga., d. 11 Jun 1908, Elberton, Ga., married 30 Jan 1901 to Cynthia E. Hunter. Son of Dr. Long. Occupation, druggist.

[2] **Long, Cora Celestia Stroud**, b. Jun 1854, Alabama, d. 13 Jan 1944, San Antonio, Tx., married 25 Oct 1877 to Edward Crawford Long, son of Dr. Long. Moved to Athens, Ga., c1877, moved to San Antonio, Tx., in 1883.

[2] **Long, Cynthia E. Hunter**, b. 1879, Georgia, d. unknown, married 30 Jan 1901 to Arthur Beaugard Long, son of Dr. Long.

[2] **Long, David Swain**, b. 1861, Athens, Ga., d. Apr 1862, Athens, Ga. Son of Dr. Long.

[2] **Long, Edward Crawford**, b. 11 Jan 1852, Athens, Ga., d. 24 July 1834, San Antonio, Tx., married 25 Oct 1877 to Cora Celestia Stroud. Son of Dr. Long. Moved to San Antonio, Tx., in 1883. Trained as a druggist by his father; was permanently injured in a 1888 train accident in Comfort, Tx., which killed his mother; worked in real estate.

[2] **Long, Edward Crawford**, b. 7 Nov 1880, in Athens, Ga., d. 31 Oct 1951, in Athens, Ga., married c1905 to Louise Braithwaite. Grandson of Dr. Long; son of Edward Crawford Long. Lived with his family in San Antonio, Tx., starting in 1883. Occupation, civil engineer; as an adult lived and worked in Pennsylvania and Tennessee.

[1] **Long, Elizabeth Ware**, b. 22 Mar 1789, Virginia, d. 21 May 1856, Athens, Ga., married 8 Dec 1813 to James Long. Mother of Dr. Long. Her family moved from Virginia to Madison County, Ga., in 1791.

[2] **Long, Ella Caroline**, b. 8 Oct 1849, Jefferson, Ga., d. 1 Jul 1859 Athens, Ga. Daughter of Dr. Long.

[2] **Long, Emma Mitchell**, b. 28 Oct 1859, Athens, Ga., d. 10 Jul 1935, Athens, Ga. Daughter of Dr. Long. Lived with her parents until 1878, then with her mother until 1888; thereafter lived with her sister, Sarah Frances Long Taylor, in northern Mississippi and Athens, Ga.

[8] **Long, Frances Gholston**, b. 26 Jan 1828, Madison County, Ga., d. 21 Jun 1896, Madison County, Ga. Married James Samuel Long 26 Dec 1846.

[2] **Long, Francis Taylor**, b. 17 Dec 1864, Athens, Ga., d. 1865, Athens, Ga. Son of Dr. Long.

[8] **Long, Henry J.**, b. 1835, Madison County, Ga., d. 1853, Madison County, Ga. First cousin of Dr. Long; son of Thomas Wilson Long.

[2] **Long, Henry Russell Jones**, b. 23 Jul 1823, Madison County, Ga., d. 18 Nov 1888, Athens, Ga., married 26 May 1847 to Susan Jane Stroud. Brother of Dr. Long. Received his medical degree from the University of Pennsylvania, operated a medical practice and a drugstore in Athens, Ga., in partnership with his brother.

- [6] **Long, Isabella Weakly McCurdy**, b. 4 May 1795, Pennsylvania, d. 15 Nov 1859, Madison County, Ga. Married Thomas Wilson Long in 1812. The McCurdy family was among the Revolutionary War veterans who received land grants in Georgia, and traveled from Pennsylvania with the Longs.
- [2] **Long, James**, b. 4 Apr 1781, Pennsylvania, d. 9 Mar 1853, Madison County, Ga., married 8 Dec 1813 to Elizabeth Ware. Father of Dr. Long. Moved with his family in 1787-88 from Pennsylvania to Madison County, Ga. He owned the town's first store and first tavern, established the first flour mill in northeast Georgia, was Danielsville's first postmaster, and a founder of Danielsville Academy and the Georgia Railroad. Served as Clerk of the Court, representative to the state legislature, and member of state senate.
- [2] **Long, James Henry**, b. 1 Mar 1844, Jefferson, Ga., d. 28 Apr 1845, Jefferson, Ga. Son of Dr. Long.
- [8] **Long, James Samuel**, b. 18 Mar 1826, Madison County, Ga., d. 21 Jun 1891, Madison County, Ga., married Frances Gholston 26 Dec 1846. Occupation: farmer. First cousin of Dr. Long; son of Thomas Wilson Long.
- [9] **Long, James William**, b. 1852, Clarke County, Ga., d. 1897, Clarke County, Ga. Married Julia Dorroh 5 May 1875. Occupation: farmer. Dr. Long's nephew; son of his brother, Henry R.J. Long.
- [8] **Long, John David**, b. 19 Mar 1824, Madison County, Ga., d. 18 Oct 1875, Jefferson, Ga., married Mary E. Watson 3 Feb 1850. Occupation: physician. Apprenticed with Dr. Long in Jefferson, graduated from Georgia Medical College, Augusta, Ga. in 1847, purchased practice of Dr. Long in 1850. First cousin of Dr. Long; son of Thomas Wilson Long.
- [8] **Long, Joseph Brown**, b. 23 Sep 1817, Madison County, Ga., d. 13 Dec 1893, Madison County, Ga., married Sarah Lucetta Groves 15 Oct 1840. First cousin of Dr. Long; son of Thomas Wilson Long.
- [9] **Long, Julia Dorroh**, b. 1855, Perry County, Ala., d. 1876, Clarke County, Ga.
- [2] **Long, Louise Braithwaite**, b. 1882 d. 1944, married c1905 to Edward Crawford Long. Dr. Long's grandson.
- [8] **Long, Lula**, b. 1820, Madison County, Ga., d. 1859, Athens, Ga. First cousin of Dr. Long; daughter of Thomas Wilson Long.
- [2] **Long, Marion Sims**, b. 6 Oct 1878, d. 15 Oct 1880. Grandson of Dr. Long. Born and died in Athens, Ga.
- [2] **Long, Mary Caroline Swain**, b. 14 Dec 1825, Jackson County, Ga., d. 22 Sep 1888, Comfort, Tx., in a train accident, married 11 Aug 1842 to Dr. Long.
- [2] **Long, Mary Elizabeth**, b. 28 Nov 1847, Jefferson, Ga., d. 5 May 1849, Jefferson, Ga. Daughter of Dr. Long.
- [8] **Long, Mary E. Watson**, b. 6 Feb 1831, Jackson County, Ga., d. 11 Dec 1894, Jefferson, Ga., married John David Long 3 Feb 1850.
- [6] **Long, Mary "Polly" Fryar**, b. 1795, Tennessee, d. Nov 1859, Tippah County, Mississippi, married Samuel Long in 1816.
- [2] **Long, Maud Eudora**, b. 28 Feb 1863, Athens, Ga., d. 5 Apr 1882, Athens, Ga. Daughter of Dr. Long.
- [6] **Long, Samuel**, b. 1753, Donegal, Ireland, d. 7 Jul 1822, Madison County, Ga. Grandfather of Dr. Long. Samuel and two of his brothers left Ireland, settled in Pennsylvania, and fought in the Revolutionary War. He married Ann Williamson in 1780 and was awarded land in Georgia as payment for his War service. Long, among a group of land grant awardees, left Pennsylvania in 1787 and arrived in Madison County, Ga., in 1788. Occupation: farmer.
- [6] **Long, Samuel**, b. abt 1796, Madison County, Ga., d. abt 1857, Tippah County, Mississippi, married Mary "Polly" Fryar in 1816. Son of Samuel and Ann Williamson Long, uncle of Dr. Long. Occupation: farmer.
- [8] **Long, Sarah Lucetta Groves**, b. 30 Nov 1818, Madison County, Ga., d. 12 Dec 1899, Madison County, Ga., married Joseph Brown Long 15 Oct 1840. The Groves family was among the Revolutionary War veterans who received land grants in Georgia, and traveled from Pennsylvania with the Longs.
- [8] **Long, Sidney Catherine "Kate" Woods**, b. 29 Jan 1838, Madison County, Ga., d. 24 May 1891, Madison County, Ga., married Thomas Alexander Long 23 Feb 1860.
- [8] **Long, Susan**, b. 1820, Madison County, Ga., d. 1844, Madison County, Ga. First cousin of Dr. Long; daughter of Thomas Wilson Long.
- [2] **Long, Susan Jane Stroud**, b. 15 Dec 1828, Clarke County, Ga., d. 1894, Clarke County, Ga., married 26 May 1847 to Henry Russell Jones Long, Dr. Long's brother. Aunt of Cora C. Stroud, wife of Edward Crawford Long.
- [8] **Long, Thomas Alexander**, b. 7 Mar 1831, Madison County, Ga., d. 17 Jul 1910, Madison County, Ga., married Sidney Catherine "Kate" Woods 23 Feb 1860. Occupation: farmer. First cousin of Dr. Long; son of Thomas Wilson Long.
- [6] **Long, Thomas Wilson**, b. 15 Sep 1784, Pennsylvania, d. 21 Jul 1861. Uncle of Dr. Long. Married Isabella Weakly McCurdy in 1812. Occupation: farmer.
- [9] **Long, William Julian**, b. 1876, Clarke County, Ga., d. 1888, Clarke County, Ga. Dr. Long's grand-nephew; son of James William Long.

[1] **Mitchell, Giles**, b. 5 Oct 1805, Clarke County, Ga., d. 1869, Clarke Co., Ga., married 1835 to Sarah Ann Elinor Long, sister of Dr. Long. Resided most of his life in Jackson County, Ga. Owner of one of two large plantations adjoining Jefferson, Ga., to the north. His home, still in existence, faces Jefferson's Lawrenceville Street. Mitchell moved his family to Clarke County, Ga., c1860, where many generations of Mitchells had made their home. Occupation, attorney.

[4] **Swain, Carolyn**, b. 22 Nov 1789, d. 15 Sep 1792. Sister of Dr. Long's father-in-law, George D. Swain.

[4] **Swain, David Lowry**, b. 4 Jan 1801, Buncombe County, N.C., d. 27 Aug 1868, Chapel Hill, N.C., married c1825 to Eleanor Hope White. Governor of North Carolina 1832-35, President of the University of North Carolina 1835-1868. Brother of Dr. Long's father-in-law, George D. Swain.

[4] **Swain, Eleanor Hope White**, b. 10 Apr 1800, d. 4 Feb 1883, to David Lowry Swain.

[4] **Swain, Frances Taylor**, b. 8 Aug 1803, d. 1829, Jackson County, Ga., married 26 Dec 1822 to George D. Swain. Dr. Long's mother-in-law. Eldest of 13 children born to John Taylor and Mary Polly Knott Taylor.

[4] **Swain, George Charles**, b. 17 Jun 1763, d. 24 Dec 1829, married 2 Dec 1788 to Carolyn Aycock Lane Lowry. Dr. Long's wife's paternal grandfather.

[4] **Swain, George D.**, b. 30 Aug 1792, Georgia, d. 1877, Athens, Ga., married 26 Dec 1822 to Frances Taylor. Dr. Long's wife's father, he lived with Dr. Long's family in his final years. Occupation, farmer and trader.
